2. Authorising Provisions

These regulations are made under clauses 33, 37 and 43 of the Constitution

3. Application

These regulations apply to the Education Council as established by these regulations using the power in clause 43.1 of the Constitution.

4. Membership

4.1 The members of the Education Council are:

- (a) the Education Vice-President (chair);
- (b) all student representatives on University committees nominated by the Student Union; and
- (c) 1 representative nominated by each club or society affiliated as a Faculty Club or Society as per the Clubs and Societies Council Regulations.

4.2 All members of the Education Council must be Student Members as defined in clause 7 of the Constitution.

4.3 Members of the Education Council are Governing Members of the Student Union as defined in clause 8 of the Constitution

5. Powers and Responsibilities

5.1 The powers and responsibilities of the Clubs and Societies Council are to advance the education policies and education activism of the La Trobe Student Union (**Student Union**) by:

- (a) formulating education policies for the Student Union; and
- (b) facilitating co-operation between the education departments of the Student Union, student representatives on University Committees and Faculty Clubs or Societies.

6. Meetings of the Education Council

6.1 The Education Council must meet at least 4 during the two University semesters.

6.2 Before the first meeting of a University semester, the Student Union must publish a schedule of meetings of the Education Council for that University semester by:

- (a) notice posted on the Student Union website; and

- (b) email to each member of the Education Council

6.3 The Chair of the Education Council is the Education Vice-President.

6.4 Despite clause 64.2 of the Constitution, if the Education Vice-President is unable or does not wish to chair a meeting of the Clubs and Societies Council, they may nominate a member of the Executive of the Student Union to chair the meeting.

6.5 If neither the Education Vice-President nor a nominated member of the Executive is able to chair the meeting, the Education Council must elect another Education Council member to chair the meeting.

7. Voting at Meetings

Voting at meetings is to be conducted as specified in clause 66 of the Constitution.

8. Discipline

8.1 The standard of conduct required of members of the Education Council is the standard of conduct described in the Student Union Code of Conduct.

8.2 The discipline of members of the Education Council is to be conducted as specified in the Student Union Discipline Regulations.

9. Affiliated Faculty Clubs or Societies

9.1 Affiliated Faculty Clubs or Societies are those Faculty Clubs or Societies that:

- (a) apply for affiliation;
- (b) meet the conditions of affiliation; and
- (c) are affiliated by the Clubs and Societies Council.

in accordance with the Clubs and Societies Regulations.
