## EDUCATION NETWORK

### 1. Contents

### 2. Authorising Provisions

These regulations are made under clauses 33, 37 and 43 of the Constitution.

### 3. Application

These regulations apply to the Education Network as established by these regulations using the power in clause 43.1 of the Constitution.

### 4. Membership

- 4.1 The members of the Education Network are:
- (a) the Education Vice-President (co-chair), the Education Public Affairs Officer/s (co-chair/s);
  - (b) all student representatives on University committees nominated by the Student Union; and

- 4.2 All members of the Education Network must be Student Members as defined in clause 7 of the Constitution.

- 4.3 Members of the Education Network are Governing Members of the Student Union as defined in clause 8 of the Constitution

### 5. Powers and Responsibilities

- 5.1 The powers and responsibilities of the Education Network are to advance the education policies and education activism of the La Trobe Student Union (**Student Union**) by:
- (a) formulating education policies for the Student Union; and
  - (b) facilitating co-operation between the education departments of the Student Union, student representatives on University Committees and Faculty Clubs or Societies.

### 6. Meetings of the Education Network

- 6.1 The Education Network must meet at least 4 times during each of the two University semesters.
- 6.2 Before the first meeting of a University semester, the Student Union must publish a schedule of meetings of the Education Network for that University semester by:
- (a) notice posted on the Student Union website; and

(b) email to each member of the Education Network

6.3 The Chairs of the Education Network are the Education Vice-President and the Education Public Affairs Officer/s.

6.4 If neither the Education Vice-President nor a nominated member of the Executive is able to chair the meeting, the Education Network must elect another Education Network member to chair the meeting.

## **7. Voting at Meetings**

Voting at meetings is to be conducted as specified in clause 66 of the Constitution.

## **8. Discipline**

8.1 The standard of conduct required of members of the Education Network is the standard of conduct described in the Student Union Code of Conduct.

8.2 The discipline of members of the Education Network is to be conducted as specified in the Student Union Discipline Regulations.
